Mahamaham Tank - A sacred tank where the Mahamaham Festival occurs every 12 years.

Kasi Viswanathar Temple - A Shiva temple associated with the Mahamaham Festival.

Chakrapani Temple - Dedicated to Lord Vishnu in a rare Sudarshana Chakra form.

Navagraha Temples (Around Kumbakonam)

Thingalur Chandran Temple (Moon) - Dedicated to the Moon god.

Thirunageswaram Rahu Temple (Rahu) - Famous for the milk abhishekam turning blue.

Alangudi Guru Temple (Jupiter) - One of the most visited Navagraha temples

Suriyanar Temple (Sun) - Dedicated to the Sun god.
